


CORNHOLE GAME INSTRUCTIONS


CORNHOLE IS A TRADITIONAL AMERICAN OUTDOOR GAME INVOLVING 2-4 PLAYERS. IT'S VERSATILE ENOUGH TO PLAY IN YOUR BACKYARD, AT A PARK, ON THE BEACH OR WHILE CAMPING. CORNHOLE'S INTENDED TO BE PLAYED WITH TWO BOARDS BUT YOU CAN ALSO PLAY WITH ONE, AS OUTLINED BELOW.

THE PREP

- 1. Open your cornhole board
- 2. Place the board 27 feet (8.23 metres) away
- 3. Draw up a foul line where players' front feet can't cross



 Pick your teams and divide the bean bags between players (four bags for each team)



THE PLAY

- The first team pitches one bean bag from behind the foul line with an underhand release, aiming for the cornhole board
- 2. The second team similarly pitches one bean bag
- 3. Subsequent tosses alternate between team one and team two
- 4. After all bean bags have been thrown, players walk down to the board to calculate their scores
- 5. Three points are scored for a Cornhole or one point is scored for a Woody (see definitions under 'The lingo' section)
- 6. Any bean bag that comes to rest touching both the ground and the board doesn't count as a point
- 7. Cancellation scoring is most common, where the points of one team cancel out the points of the other team (similar to bowls)
- The next frame begins with the team that scored points in the preceding frame, or if scores were tied, retain the same throwing order as the preceding frame
- 9. The first team to 21 points, wins

THE LINGO



CORNHOLE

A bean bag that's thrown through the hole (3 POINTS)



THE GREAT CORNHOLIO

Term for a player who throws all four bean bags in the hole



WOODY

A bean bag that lands on the board (1 POINT)



GET THAT CORN OUTTA MY FACE!

Expression used when knocking your opponent's bean bag off the board



DOS CORNHOLE

Throwing two bean bags through the hole during a single frame (6 POINTS)



CORN ON THE COB

Phrase used when a player lands every one of their bean bags on the board



HOLY MOLY TRIPLE CORNHOLY

Throwing three bean bags through the hole during a single frame (9 POINTS)



NOTHIN' BUT CORN

Catchphrase used after a bean bag is thrown right through the hole without touching the board

THE TRADITION

The official American Cornhole rules outline the use of two cornhole boards within a court area that includes four pitching zones. Ends are played (again, similar to bowls) until the winning team scores 21 points.
